

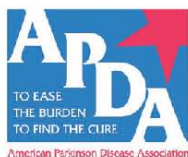
About

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Today more than 1.5 million Americans are afflicted with Parkinson's Disease (PD) and an estimated 10,000 people with PD live here in the State of Utah. PD is a progressive neurological disease with symptoms that include tremors, slowness of movement and loss of muscle control. Currently there is no known cure for PD. With proper medication, nutrition and exercise, people suffering with PD are able to significantly reduce the debilitating effects of the symptoms of Parkinson's disease."

The "Play Your Part in the Fight Against Parkinson's disease" fundraiser is the most important event to provide fiscal support to the Utah Chapter of the American Parkinson Disease Association (APDA). The Utah Chapter of ADPA funds research and education on both local and national levels. It provides regular speakers for those families who are affected by the disease.
